



Seaway Valley Blazer Coach's and Manager's Code Of Conduct

The Seaway Valley Blazers Coach's and Manager's Code of Conduct has been created to instill in each member the principles of good sportsmanship and teamwork through the knowledge and participation in the competitive sport of soccer. Our players, parents, opponents, coaches, representatives and officials are to be treated with respect at all times. There shall be a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for misconduct or violent/dangerous actions by the team coaches and managers. It is the obligation of the coaches and managers to create and maintain an environment that promotes these principles. We all must remember that our actions are a reflection of both the SVSC and our community. Those who violate this Code of Conduct will jeopardize their opportunity to participate in this program.

Coaches / Managers:

The role of the coaches and managers are one of teaching sportsmanship and soccer skills to the players. The coaches and managers are also responsible for monitoring their own behavior and the behavior of the players, parents and other representatives during all practices and games. By signing below, that individual agrees to abide by this Code of Conduct, and acknowledges that participation in the SVSC youth soccer program is a privilege and not a right. To meet these responsibilities, the coaches and the manager are expected to:

1. Adhere to the SVSC Constitution.
2. Instruct players and parents in the law of the game and motivate each player to compete according to the laws at all times.
3. Show respect and courtesy to game officials at all times. Refrain from questioning their decisions or challenging their authority.
4. Ensure that parents/spectators of his/her team exhibit good sportsmanship at all times.
5. Abstain from using abusive or profane language and avoid conduct that could be insulting, degrading, or humiliating.
6. Teach and practice good sportsmanship and fair play by personally demonstrating commitment to these principles.
7. Treat players, parents, opponents, coaches, and officials with respect.
